



PLANNING BOARD MEETING

June 24, 2010

The regular monthly meeting of the Bradley Planning Board opened at 6:35 p.m. this date in the council room at the Town Office, with the following people present: Board Members, Ch. Linda Hardesty, Sharon Dill & Frank Kearney; Town Officials: CEO Charles Norburg. There were no other citizens present.

The meeting began with the salute to the flag of our country.

The minutes of the May 20th meeting were unanimously approved.

There were no Citizens' Requests.

The proposed Section VI.L.f. (Appeals – Variances) of the proposed Land Use Ordinance was reviewed by the Board. Its inclusion was moved by Kearney, seconded by Dill and unanimously approved.

A new writing of the sub-section on signs, §V.A.29. was presented by the CEO, his feeling was that the originally proposed sub-sub§ 29 did not fully cover many contingencies that may arise and needed to be addressed. Conversely, this new presentation may include items that are not applicable to Bradley. After some discussion it was agreed that the Board members would take the proposal home for study. It is also E-mailed as an attachment so that all members may have a chance to look it over.

There was no other business to come before the Board at this time.

Because members would not be available for our scheduled meeting in July, our next meeting will be on **July 29 @ 6:45 p.m.** (Note date and time change), with the possibility of skipping the August meeting. Hopefully, the Ordinance will be ready to present to the Town Council after this meeting. Come prepared to spend an evening!
