Discussion continued from the previous meeting with the applicant in attendance (Amy and Chris Albert).

Code Enforcement Officer summarized the previous month's discussion, indicating there remained safety issues that needed to be addressed and/or clarified by the applicant, prior to any action on the application.

The Code Enforcement Officer notified the board that he had been in discussions with the applicant regarding the additional issues that needed to be addressed. He advised the applicant that primarily safety related issues such as ingress, egress, flammable storage, maneuvering of cars, ADA compliance and firewall protection.

Chris Albert explained that he had constructed two 5/8 sheet-rocked interior walls separating the garage area from the retail space. Fire extinguishers are present along with smoke detectors in the building. The entrance to the building is almost at ground level, but he would make the necessary alterations to comply with the requirements of the American Disabilities Act. Fans are present and can be used if necessary to remove fumes from the building as it was formerly suitable for car painting.

Chris further indicated that there would be no plumbing installed and would seek the required electrical inspection from the State Electrical Inspector.

The Planning Board, having no further questions took the following actions:

Planning Board Action: Motion was made and seconded to approve the application for the establishment of a consignment shop to be located within the building currently housing Blue Collar Yard Pros, with the following conditions below: Vote: 4-0

1. Exit signs are to be properly installed and clearly marked.

*** Suggested Ramp**
