Dear Ms. Doane,

This letter is to notify the Town of Bradley that ND Paper Old Town ("ND OTM LLC") has established a designated area with two cardboard containers for recycling by Portland St. This innovative idea, designed to improve local recycling and ultimately reduce disposal alternatives like landfilling, is expected to provide an opportunity for the residents of the Town of Bradley to drop their cardboard waste in the containers for recycling.

Sustainability is a crucial element of ND Paper's vision for the next 100 years. In ND Paper Old Town, we are thrilled to contribute to this vision while being a proactive partner of the community. The containers will be for **CARDBOARD ONLY** and the area will be monitored 24 hours a day to ensure no household trash is placed inside the containers. The new recycling containers will be located in front of the ND Contractor Parking lot by 24 Portland St as shown in Attachment 1. In addition, there will be signage that will guide the residents in the correct direction. Although this is for **RESIDENTIAL USE ONLY**, it may be expanded to businesses in the future.

What type of cardboard is allowed?

- Corrugated cardboard (e.g. package boxes from online retailers...)
- Paperboard (e.g. cereal boxes, food packaging boxes, drinks boxes...)
- Pizza boxes WITHOUT the plastic pizza saver nor the wax paper.

What type of waste is NOT allowed?

- Household garbage (e.g. burned out light bulbs, food scraps, bottles...)
- Industrial garbage
- Newspapers or office waste
- Plastic waste or glass waste
